

The **Faculty of Sports Sciences of Aix-Marseille University** offers **undergraduate** and **postgraduate** training in four key areas:



- **Physical Activities and Health,**
- **Sports Management,**
- **Sports and Physical Education,**
- **Research and Development** around **Human Movement** including **Human Factors, Ergonomics and Biomechanics,** and **Bio-engineering** of Tissues and Transplants.

Most courses available to exchange students are taught in French; therefore, a minimum **B1 level in French is required**. To support international students, a **French language course** is offered by the university during the mobility.



Our **Bachelor programs** are designed to provide students with a broad-based, multidisciplinary scientific foundation combined with professional skills development. **Four specializations** are accessible:

- **Adapted Physical Activity and Health (APAS)**
- **Education and Motor Skills** – Physical Education Teacher Training for Secondary Schools (General EM)
- **Ergonomics of Sport and Motor Performance (ESPM)**
- **Sport Management (MS)**

Our **Master programs** offer a complementary range of specialized study tracks with **Four specializations**:

- **Adapted Physical Activity and Health (APAS)**
- **Training and Optimization of Sport Performance (EOPS)**
- **Engineering and Ergonomics of Physical Activity (IEAP)**
- **Sport Management (MS)**

Within the IEAP Master's program, students may further specialize in one of the following study tracks:

- **Bioengineering of Tissues and Implants (BTI)**
- **Human Factors (HF)**
- **Engineering and Ergonomics of Human Movement (IEHM)**
